Important information is often difficult to find, particularly when it is needed urgently. Therefore, it is important that you keep clear documented records of your personal details and finances. This Personal Record Book will act as an important information source for loved ones, if for some reason you are unable to attend to your own affairs.

We recommend that you keep this document in a safe and accessible place that is known to at least two other people It is also important that all your estate planning documents are up-to-date and that this information is included in your Personal Record Book.

ARE YOU AN EXECUTOR?

Being an executor of a Will can be a complex and time consuming task. Many people appoint a friend or relative as a way of acknowledging their respect or admiration for that person. However, being left with the burden of administering a loved one's estate can be a distressing task during a time of grief.

If you have been named the executor of a Will you are under no legal obligation to accept this appointment. Taking on the responsibility may not be the right thing for you and it is unlikely that the person who nominated you would have wanted to put you under stress.

If you don't wish to act as executor you can renounce and transfer the role to an independent professional executor, such as the Public Trustee. Once a person has obtained a grant of probate, it is generally not possible for that person to renounce the appointment.
